Safety is a priority for every electric cooperative, and to that end the Board of Directors of the Colorado Electric Educational Institute (CEEI) wants to reinforce the value it puts on the safety of the people participating in its programs. This includes, but is not limited to, the safety of students participating in education and youth programs, instructors, chaperones, co-op employees, and the public at large.

It is the position of the CEEI Board of Directors that it will not tolerate actions that could put others in jeopardy. This zero tolerance policy can be especially difficult to carry out as it relates to the youth programs. However, it is the chaperones' responsibility to ensure the safety of our students and fellow chaperones. The CEEI Board urges those participating in these programs to monitor the behavior of students and chaperones and immediately stop and/or report this behavior to the appropriate program director. A code of conduct for students and chaperones should be distributed prior to the start of the event. Participants who are not willing to follow the safety guidelines may be sent home.
